Digital Foodie technology is based on cloud architecture and a recommendation engine. With Foodie.fm, the user may express his opinion by voting on things he likes or dislikes. Foodie.fm combines sophisticated mathematical modeling, cognitive learning, semantic data mining, profiling and actual user location to provide users with meal and product suggestions that they will most probably like.

Responsibilities

As a Web Developer your responsibility is to develop web interfaces for multitude of Foodie.fm services. Your task is to develop a front end for managing and viewing analytics and other attributes of Foodie.fm service through holistic web interface. Your responsibilities also include participating in development of Foodie.fm consumer front end along with the other members of the team.

You will be working as an integrated member of foodie.fm server development team. Foodie.fm service is implemented mainly with Ruby. Client applications vary from multitude of mobile handsets such as iPhone, QT and Android to web applications and widgets.

Requirements

To succeed in this position, you need to have 3-6 years of experience in web front-end technologies, such as ajax, xml, html, css and solid understanding of backend technologies like Ruby or PHP and SQL. Knowledge of other programming and scripting languages is considered an advantage. Fluent English language skill is mandatory, additional spoken languages are a big plus. You should have eye for detail and experience in good user interface development.
